## Irregular Verbs

Some verbs change their basic form to show past tense.

eat-ate

do-did

Some of these verbs change their basic form again to show past tense with a helping verb.

eat-ate-has eaten

do-did-has done

Below are some irregular verbs you often use.

present	past alone	past with a helping verb
1. do	did	done
2. eat	ate	eaten
3. give	gave	given
4. go	went	gone
5. see	saw	seen
6. take	took	taken
